Contract for Future Intake

This Contract for Future Intake (“Agreement”) is entered into this ____ day of _____, 20____, by and between _____ (“Owner”) and Florida Exotic Bird Sanctuary Inc. (“FEBS”).

Owner wishes to place the bird(s) identified in the table below with FEBS for lifetime care, but does not have a date-certain for such placement in mind at the moment. By executing this Agreement, Owner is reserving space at FEBS for permanent placement of the bird(s) on a future date of Owner’s choosing. Owner understands and agrees that the future acceptance of the bird(s) by FEBS for residence at the sanctuary will be contingent on the bird(s) passing a medical examination by the avian veterinarian selected by FEBS, Owner’s compliance with the terms of this Agreement, and execution by Owner of FEBS’ then published formal bird intake contract.

This Agreement and payment of the required sponsorship donation guarantees Owner that the bird(s) named below, if/when accepted for intake at FEBS, will live the rest of its/their life in our sanctuary, will receive all necessary sustenance, shelter, medical and other care, and human and bird interaction, but will never be sold, bred, or offered for adoption. Owner understands this Agreement doesn’t guarantee that the bird(s) will be placed in a specific space at the sanctuary. (FEBS endeavors to place all parrots in an appropriate space with or near compatible birds.) Furthermore, Owner understands that the sponsorship donation doesn’t include building or purchasing a specific aviary or other enclosure for the bird(s).

Owner understands and agrees that the sponsorship donation paid or payable upon execution of this Agreement is **nonrefundable**. Owner has elected to pay the sponsorship donation in the following manner:

The sponsorship donation (\$_____) has been paid in full. No additional sponsorship donation is required so long as the bird(s) is placed for permanent residence with FEBS within five (5) years of the date of this Agreement; thereafter, Owner will be responsible for paying the difference between the then prevailing sponsorship amount and the current amount, due on the date of permanent placement.

Note (if helpful): _____

At least 50% of the sponsorship donation was paid upon signing, with the balance payable in 12 or fewer monthly installments: The specific sponsorship payment terms per this Agreement are set forth below. Should the prevailing sponsorship amount on the date of permanent placement of the bird(s) be greater than the current amount, Owner will be responsible for paying the difference at that time.

Owner understands that each bird placed with FEBS must undergo a thorough medical examination by a qualified avian veterinarian prior to final acceptance for permanent residence at the sanctuary. If the exam for the bird(s) subject to this Agreement is to be arranged by FEBS, Owner agrees to pay FEBS the then prevailing medical examination fee per bird in addition to whatever sponsorship donation may still be due at time of permanent placement.

Owner agrees to periodically notify FEBS via phone call, text message, email or USPS mail regarding the status of the subject bird(s) and Owner's then current situation. To the extent amenable to the circumstances of the future moment, Owner agrees to provide at least two weeks' notice to FEBS of the planned date for delivery of the bird(s) to the sanctuary for intake processing. Owner understands and agrees that, should Owner wish to have FEBS retrieve the bird(s) from Owner's residence for transport back to the sanctuary, Owner will be responsible for paying FEBS the reasonable costs associated with such transport.
